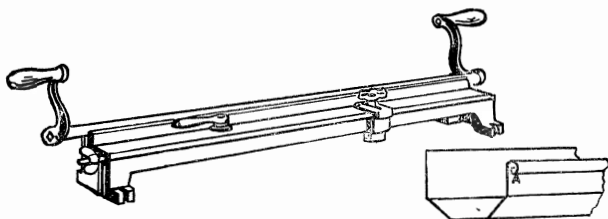

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

Gutter Beaders are intended for forming a bead on the edges of gutters. This machine is so constructed that it can be easily adjusted to be used with Rods from  $\frac{3}{8}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch in diameter. The thickness of the metal is determined by the size of the Rod. It has a Gauge or Stop on the left-hand end, so that after adjusting the Jaws and setting the Gauge for the size of the Rod to be used, the Jaws can be easily opened to remove the work and Rod, and then closed in exactly the same position as when the bead was formed, so that the operator can form any number of beads of exactly the same size. The Jaws are adjusted by a Hand Wheel with Rack and Pinion, which adjusts both ends of the movable Jaw.
